



# Update for General Practice: 'STIs in Men'

Rates of notifications for HIV and other STIs, such as syphilis, have risen dramatically in Victoria over recent years. This is particularly the case among sexually active gay men. This Update Session will provide GPs and Practice Nurses with the most up to date and relevant information on the prevalence of STIs among men who have sex with men, current testing and treatment guidelines, and management of HIV in a clinical setting.

Case studies will be examined and presenters include **Dr Louise Owen**, Clinical Director, The Centre Clinic, **Ms Anne Mitchell**, The Australian Research Centre in Sex, Health and Society, and **Associate Professor Margaret Hellard** and **Dr Mark Stoove**, The Burnet Institute.
